1. What is the time of the in-person services?

English: Sunday 11:15 am (Chapel); Cantonese: Sunday 9:15 am (Sanctuary);

**Mandarin: Sunday 11:15 am (Sanctuary)** 

2. What would be the maximum capacity for each service?

According to the government social distancing guidelines, the Sanctuary can hold up to 50 people and the Chapel can hold up to 18 people

3. How do I register to participate?

The registration will be from Thursday 10 am to Friday 11:30 pm for corresponding Sunday service (e.g. for August 15 service, registration starts on August 12 at 9:30 am to August 13 at 11:30 pm)

4. Can the whole family come?

We welcome couple to join. For family members who are 1 year or older and want to participate, they must register individually. As our Children ministry has not started its in-person ministries (e.g. Children Sunday school), the

church cannot provide children ministry services for children age 2 to 12, and children age 2 or under must be taken care of by the parents, we suggest you do not bring your children.

5. As the in-person services starts, will there continue to have livestreaming of services?

The in-person service will be held concurrently with the livestreaming (or using ZOOM) of the services, in other words, a hybrid service

- 6. What do I need to be aware of if I participate in the in-person service?
  - Please come at least 15 minutes before the service (it would be 11 am for English and Mandarin, 9 am for Cantonese) to check body temperature and going through the health questions
  - For English service, please only use the side door for entrance and exit (close to the church parking lot) and enter the door where your body temperature and health questions would be checked. Please follow the directions from the ushers to your designated seat
  - When you enter, please wear a mask or face covering, and use the sanitizer to clean your hands. Please do NOT remove your mask inside the church (special arrangement for the speaker and the song leaders)
  - Please follow the direction of the ushers and keep a 2 meter social distancing, and stay at your seat from start to finish of the service
  - If you need to go to the washroom, please do so before or after the service. For the washroom for the physically challenged, only 1 person can use at one tie, for the male and female washrooms, only 2 people can be present at all times in each washroom. Please follow the signs on the wall. When you exit the Chapel, please turn right and go through Room B10 to enter the washroom. To leave, please exit the washroom and go

along the corridor to exit at the stairs close to the Chapel, go up and exit through the parking lot doors
