(1) ACEM Summer Missions Internship - Apply NOW

To encourage the theological students to gain experience in missions field during the summer break, the ACEM Summer Missions Internship Program is now open for applications. This three-month full-time internship will be supervised by a qualified missionary agency under the coordination of the ACEM Missions Department. Salary and eligible expenses will be subsidized by ACEM.

Applicants must be full-time theological students, ACEM church members for over two years who are actively serving in an ACEM church with a passion for evangelism and global missions, and eligible to work in Canada. Applicants are required to submit a proposal that includes a recommendation letter from a lead pastor (senior pastor or pastor-in-charge) to cathy.nguyen@acem.ca. The application deadline is two months before the proposed start date of the internship.

(2) Wai Chuen & Chun Oi Chan (GO International)

Due to another wave of the COVID pandemic in Hong Kong, their flight to Brazil has again been postponed to March. May God continue to guide their ministry plans for this year and take them back to Brazil safely.
