Here are the responsibilities of the volunteers (working together with a team from Afghan church under NYCCC):

- a. Welcoming the family when they arrive at the airport.
- b. Looking for a rental place for them to stay.
- c. Visiting the family time to time
- d. Providing transportation when needed
- e. Finding school for kids and LINC classes for adults
- f. Finding second hand furniture and other home appliances
- g. Helping to find clothes and shoes for the family
- h. Inviting the family for lunch or dinner once a while

1. Login to your Internet banking account in bank website or mobile banking app.
2. Add Billing Company/Payee
 - a. BMO, RBC, TD and Scotiabank: Search "Milliken Christian Community Church"
 - b. CIBC: Search "Milliken Christian Com. Church".
3. Use the accounts numbers from above as the account number.
4. If you want to donate into multiple funds (General, Building, Missions, Thanksgiving), you will need to setup multiple Billing Company/Payee with each account number.
