Online Banking Bill Payment Offering

You will be using your 5 digits offering number to setup the Bill Payment donation process.

If your offering number only has 3 digits, please add two zeros in the front. (i.e. 00123)

Assume your Offering Number is 12345.

Here are 4 account numbers that you will be using for Bill Payment donation.

12345G / 12345B / 12345M / 12345T

- To donate into General fund, use 12345G
- To donate into Building fund, use 12345B
- To donate into Missions fund, use 12345M
- To donate into Thanksgiving fund, use 12345T
- To donate into Benevolence fund, use 12345V

Only the following banks are available for this option:

- ✓ Bank of Montreal (BMO)
- ✓ Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce (CIBC)
- ✓ Royal Bank of Canada (RBC)
- ✓ TD Canada Trust
- ✓ Scotiabank

Please follow the steps below:

1. Login to your Internet banking account via web or mobile.
2. Add Billing Company/Payee
 - a. BMO, RBC, TD and Scotiabank: Search "Milliken Christian Community Church"
 - b. CIBC: Search "Milliken Christian Com. Church".
3. Use the accounts numbers from above as the account number.
4. If you want to donate into multiple funds (General, Building, Missions, Thanksgiving), you will need to setup multiple Billing Company/Payee with each account number.
