Evan is studying in high school in Taiwan while the rest of the family minister to the Tanguat people in PNG.

Volunteers will be needed to help the family with needs such as transportation, finding housing, etc. (more details will be available later). - f. Finding secondhand furniture and other home appliances
- g. Helping to find clothes and shoes for the family
- h. Inviting the family for lunch or dinner once a while
