2. Adjustment of Field Visitation Subsidy

The Mission Department has reluctantly decided to reduce the field visitation subsidy without reducing our support for mission workers, due to the global economic impact, and expects the mission offering will be tight this year. The reduction of 10% for the Field Visitation Subsidy will be effective from January 1 to December 31, 2024. This applies to all pastors and applicants disregard the number of visits to the same field. The measure will be reviewed again in early 2025.
