6. Submit the design to mccc40logo@gmail.com., along with your name and contact information in the email
7. All entries must be submitted by October 25, 2026. The church will announce the winning entry on November 22, 2026.
8. We will put all the entries on the church bulletin board and ask for brothers and sisters to vote for the best three, from November 1 to November 15. Each person can only vote once.
9. MCCC reserved all rights to use the design for promotion purpose. The winning entry will become the properties of MCCC, and all copyrights of those logo files will belong to MCCC. The winning designer must sign a form indicating the transfer of ownership and copyright in order to be declared a winner.

B. Design Specifications:

1. Each entry must be submitted in 3 electronic files – monochrome, inverted and full color.

2. All files should only be in **EPS** or **AI** format.

(#3 and #4 below are guidelines, not requirement for submission)

3. If the submission is going to be less than 4-colors (CMYK - Cyan, Magenta, Yellow, Black), then spot colors (PANTONE) should be used.
4. The winning design will submit a vector file with color specifications (CMYK, PANTONE, RGB). It would state what the smallest size the logo can be used both in print and on screen that can still be legible.
